End of an era: why the old laboratories at RLS have to be replaced

The Science building at RLS is almost untouched since it was built for the arrival of the first students at the Chandos Road site in 1963. Laboratories are only intended to have a life of 30 years, yet the RLS laboratories have stood the test of time and lasted more than 50 years. However, the building now has severe structural defects due to foundation failure and has already been underpinned twice. The window frames have gaping holes in them and every room has to have buckets at the ready to collect rainwater through the leaking roof.

In addition, we just don't have enough laboratories. The department was built for a school population of fewer than 400 students; we now have closer to 1,300 students on roll.

The Discovery Centre

In 2012, the school boldly announced plans to build a new 12 laboratory Discovery Centre, funded by an ambitious £5m fundraising campaign – believed to be the largest launched by a state school. Two years later, £4.75m has been generated (including government funding, against all odds) and construction has begun. The Discovery Centre will open in 2015, providing that the school can raise the remaining £265,000 needed to complete and equip the laboratories.

Each laboratory in the Discovery Centre costs in excess of £100,000 to build and equip. A team of Old Latins has begun to try and make the Alumni Lab a reality, and would welcome your support.
