

Student Destinations after 16-18 study

The most recent data published by the Department for Education (in January 2019) is for students who finished level 3 (A Levels or other level 3 Qualifications) 16-18 study in 2016, the most recent data currently available to them. Higher education

This information is based on the number of Students finishing 16 to 18 study who entered higher education in 2018 at UK universities, further education colleges and other settings in the United Kingdom.
